Description: The video series includes 52 thirty-minute episodes from the popular *Destinos* telecourse originally broadcast by the Public Broadcasting Service (PBS.) The videos are designed to help students develop communicative proficiency--listening, speaking, reading, and writing--as well as cultural awareness in Spanish. The videos expose students to the rich and diversified cultures of the Spanish-speaking world. These videos were converted by Portland State to streaming video.

Test Questions

Description: Portland State faculty members have polished a large number of publisher-supplied quiz items for use in writing, grammar and listening graded quizzes. The publisher-supplied test items have been debugged, corrected and streamlined. All quizzes can be taken multiple times, and the average score counts. Portland State has also developed about 100 additional items for optional grammar quizzes if students need more practice. These questions are available in WebCT format. We anticipate that they will also be available in Blackboard format.
