BlueBook Exercises

Description: UTK faculty members have developed 4-5 online collaborative activities that correspond to the 12 chapters that are covered in the course. Their purpose is to insure that students can negotiate in Spanish (e.g., students communicate with a buddy to get certain pieces of information.) Students use email, chat or the discussion forum to communicate with one another. These activities enable instructors to see whether or not students can negotiate meaning. Students receive the

activities in class as a hard copy and then complete the planning for the exercises via email with other students in small groups.

Collaborative Homework Assignments

Description: UTK faculty members have developed about six collaborative homework assignments. These are larger tasks that span a relatively long period of time and require group effort.
